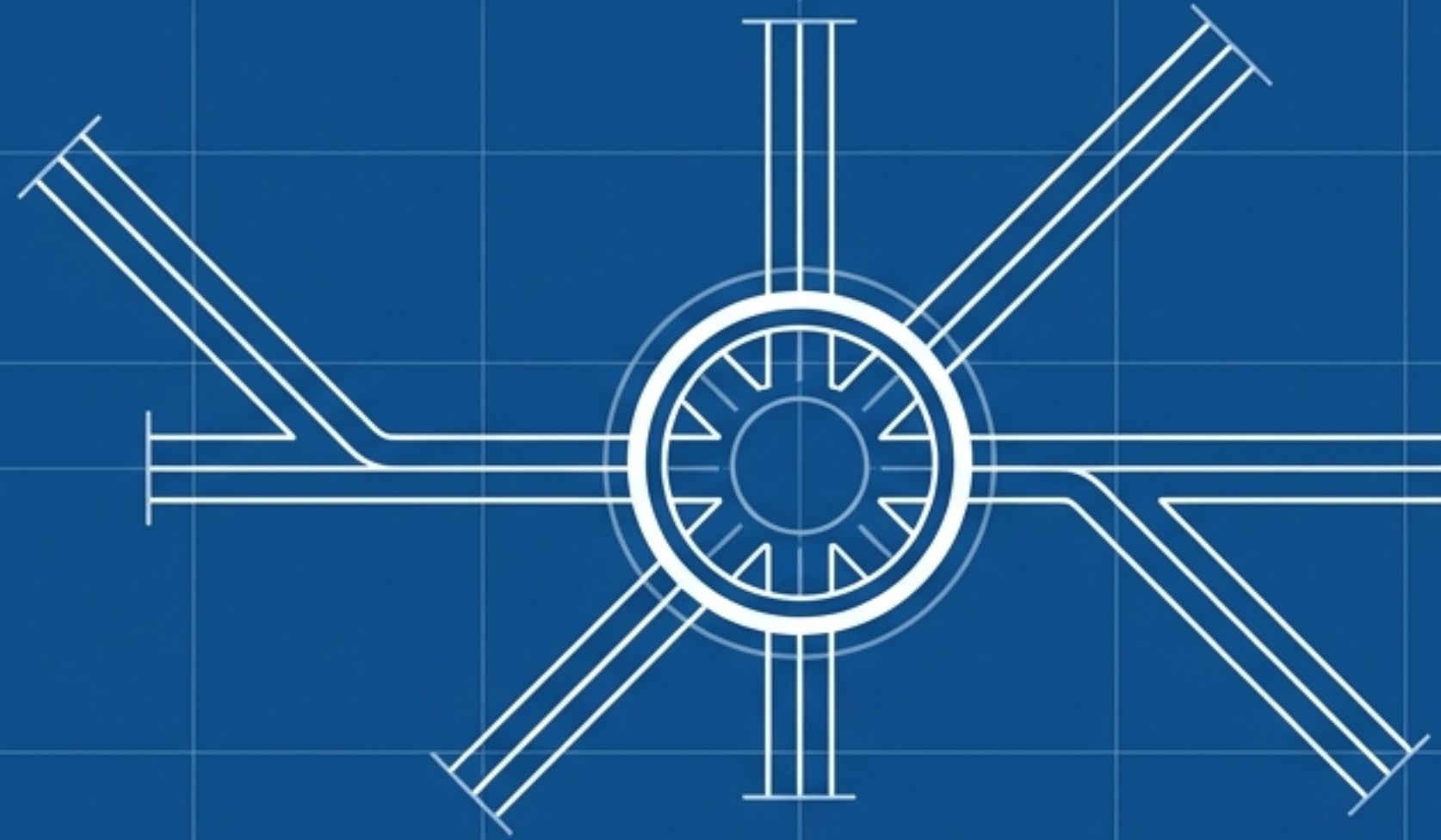
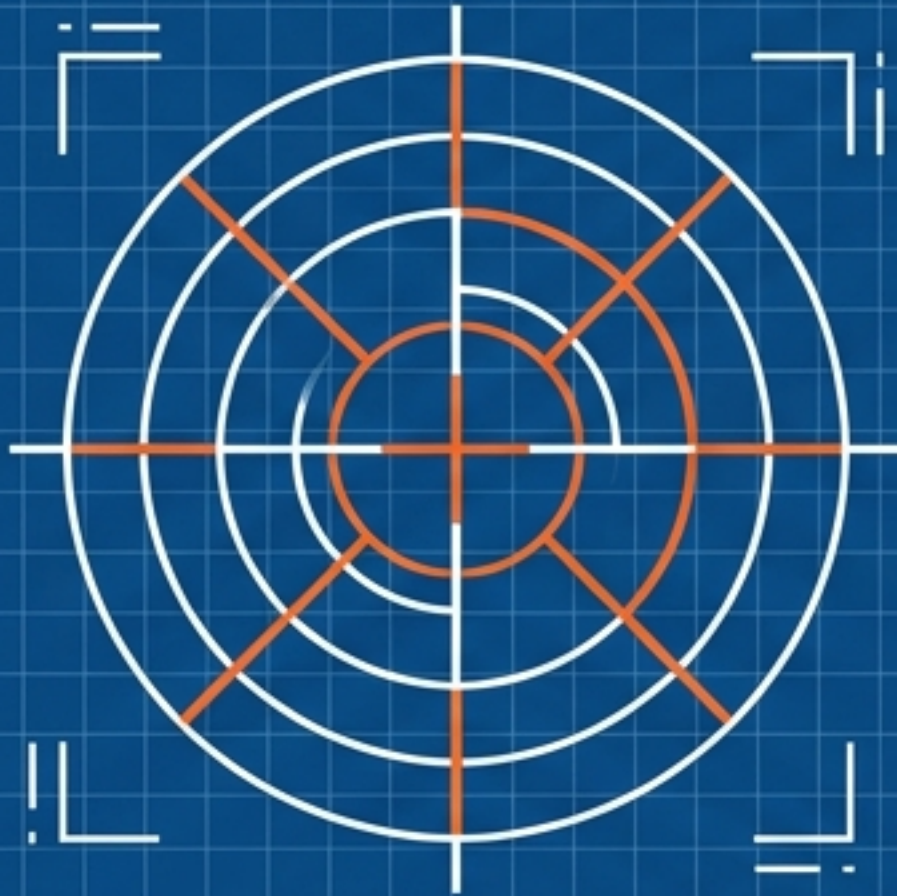

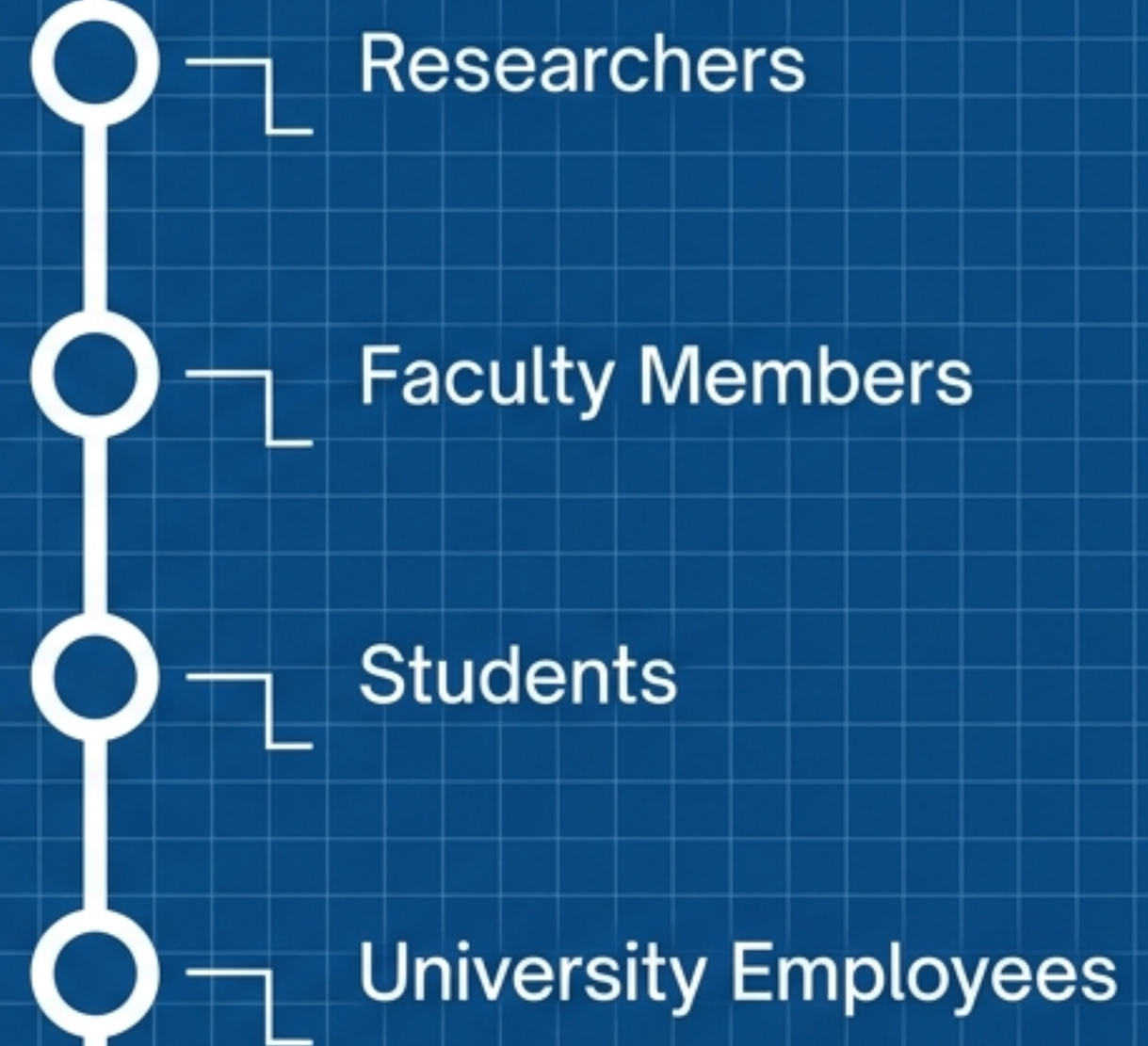

The Mandate

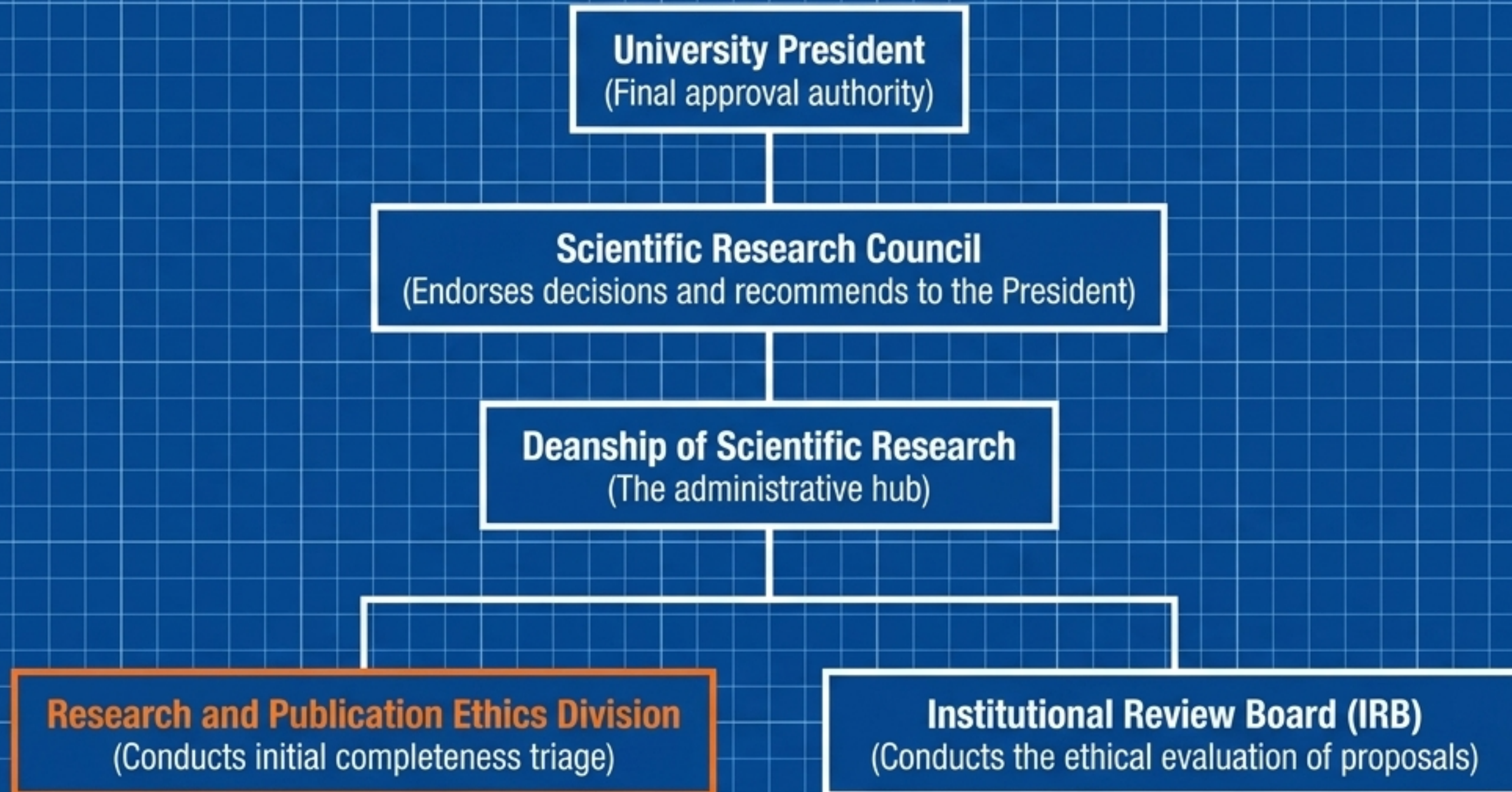
This procedure governs the submission and review of all research proposals involving human subjects at the German Jordanian University.



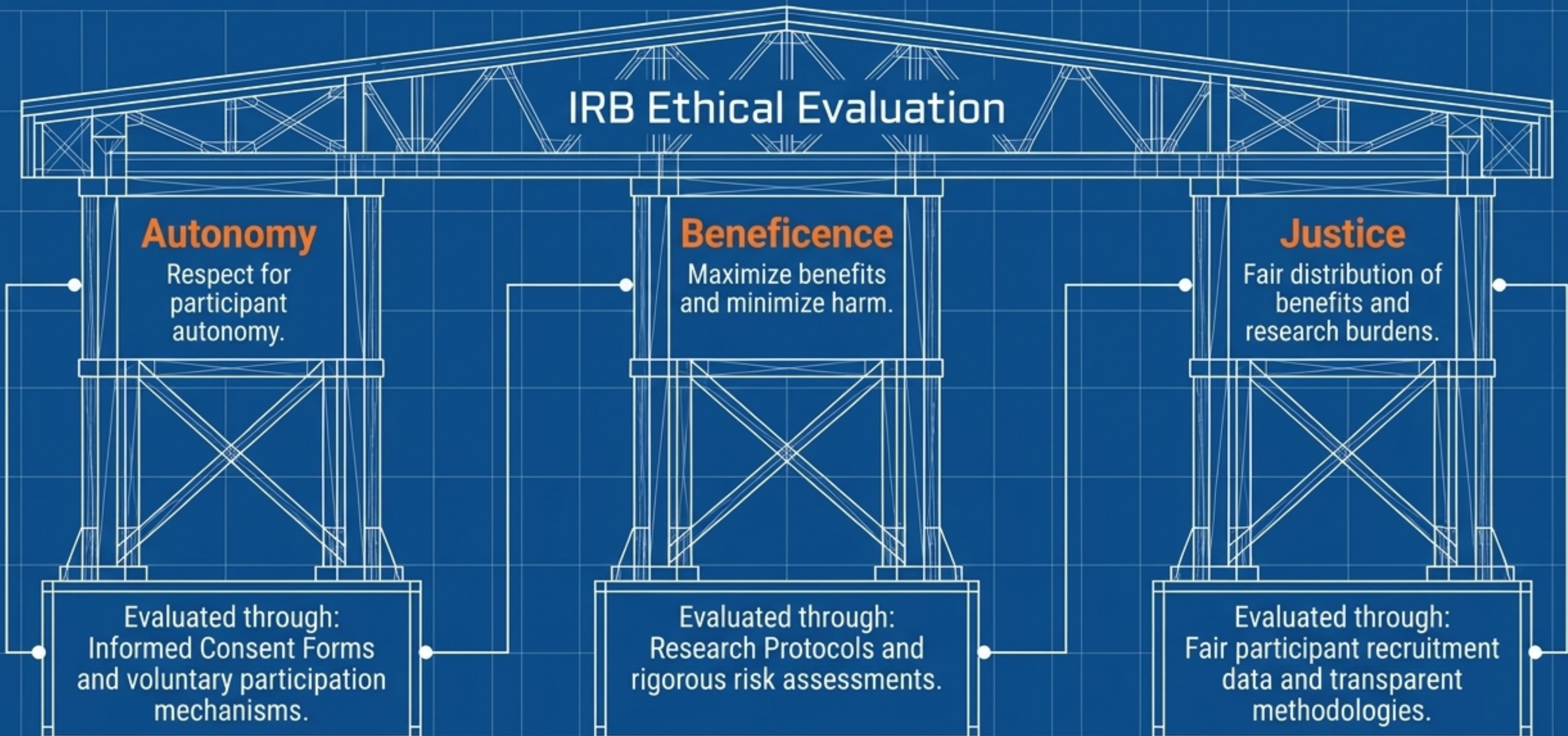
OVERSIGHT NOTE

The Entry Point

All IRB applications must be submitted directly to the Deanship through the university's electronic Ticket system.

The Prerequisite Forms

- [] **IRB Application Form**
Required baseline document
- [] **Informed Consent Forms**
Required for all human subject interactions

Research Protocols

Detailed methodology and study design.

Data Collection Tools

Surveys, questionnaires, or physical measurement tools.

The Participant Experience



Informed Consent Forms

Documentation ensuring participant autonomy.

Recruitment Data

Demographics and strategies for selecting participants.

The Researcher & Support



Funding Disclosure

Transparency regarding financial support and potential conflicts.

Curricula Vitae (CVs)

Qualifications of the primary researchers and team.

Phase 1: Submission routing and initial triage



Phase 2: Review determination and ethical evaluation

Track 1: Full Board Review

Requires approval by the complete council of IRB members.

The IRB Chair reviews the application to determine the appropriate level of scrutiny.

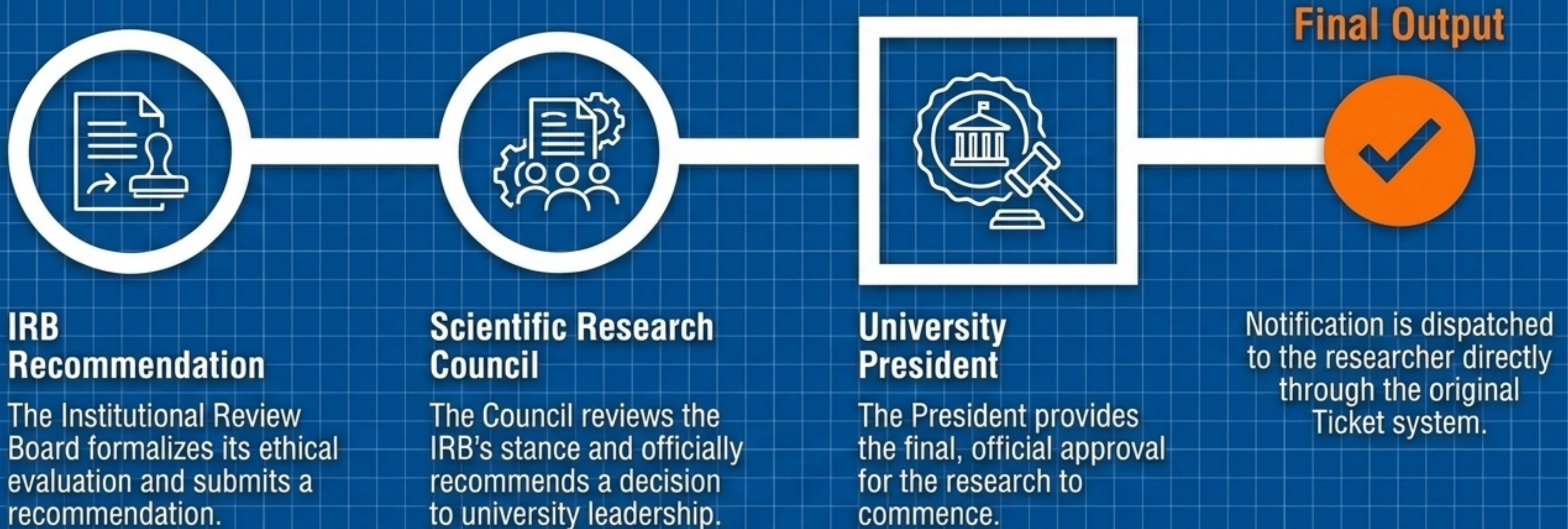
Track 2: Expedited Review

Handled by a specialized fast-track committee derived from the main council.

Autonomy | Beneficence | Justice

Regardless of the track, the proposal is rigorously evaluated against the core ethical principles.
